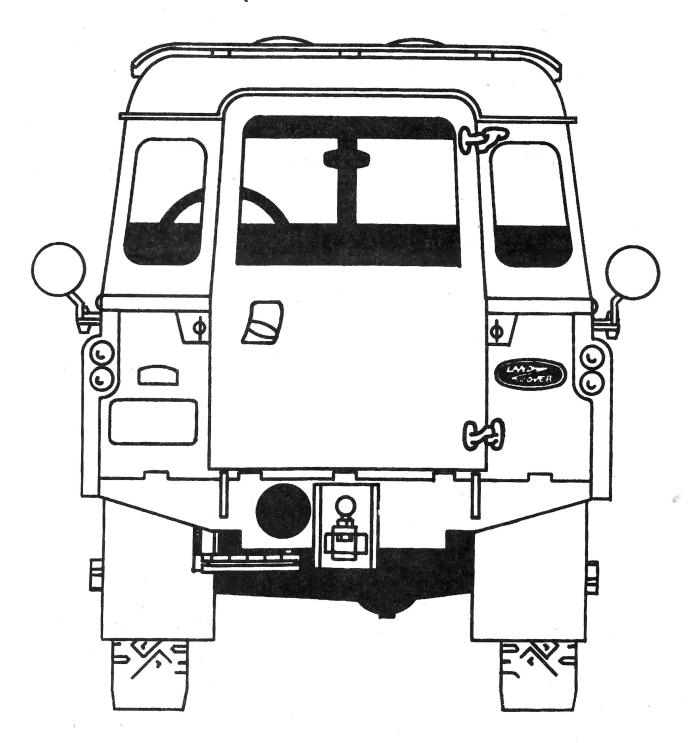

TECH TIPS-by the numbers

RC Ron Mowry also sent along a new item available for Land Rovers, a bolt on traction item for bog conditions called the 'Bog-cog'. A set of four will cost you \$663.00 from Snell Engineering, Old Sawmills, East Coker Yeovil, Somerset, England BA22 9JJ.

Member Lea Magee wrote us with some needed information on extra drain holes on the Land Rover. First area is at the front spring hanger where the bumper is bolted to the frame. The factory allows two holes at the top of this area but Lea recommends using a 1/4" or 3/8" drill to put a pair of holes at the bottom to avoid that guy Mr. Rust. Another problem area Lea relates is on the rear cross member. You will find two plastic plugs— use a screwdriver or other suitable tool to remove them, allowing water to escape.

RC Kerry Oldham sent along some information on those walk away oil filler and radiator caps. He suggests finding a suitable length of chain similar to the type used on the gas cap. Then drill a small hole on the ear of that cap, allowing for the cap to be twisted back on and anchored at a convenient spot.

Member Tom Gilbert has written asking for correspondence from any other owner with a diesel Land Rover. REQUIEM IN PIECES George F. Babits, Jr.

It's all right Old Friend... I understand. We have aged so much since that August day, 15 years ago in British Columbia. I understand, really I do. Let's just reminisce a little before I go, and look back over the years we have been together.

You rescued me from the bummers lot in Burnaby. I'd spent the first 5 years of my life with the Fish and Game, or was it the Department of Natural Resources? It's been so long now I can't remember — they just treated me roughly. My posi-trac was shot and some idiot put over-sized rings into me without a decent rebore job and new pistons. I knew you'd treat me better when you came hiking past and so I whistled, as only you would hear. Remember that salesman? He said \$1295, and me with a PTO winch and only 5 years old! What an insult. I remember you. Peeling off the \$50's and \$100's before he realized his mistake. You wanted me, as I needed you. Did you think he was going to have a heart attack? I did. You looked the hippy student that you were — blue jeans going out at the knees, tennie runners out at the toes, and a Marine Corps shirt cut off at the elbows. We were meant to be.

Next thing I knew we were headed south and east to Pullman. It wasn't but a few miles before I knew you knew Land Rovers. Later, you admitted to having had a CJ-5 between that old '59 Land Rover and me, but nobody else knew. And I wasn't about to tell.

I wanted to go with you so bad that I kind of forgot to tell you that somebody had mickey moused my rings. But I let you know pretty soon by throwing out all my oil when you had to get to Spokane. I'm sorry Old Friend, I knew you didn't have much money, but I had to get some decent rings in if I was to stay with you for a good long time. After the rings, I got you through college and then some.

Remember Montana and that time I brought you down off the mountain? It was 6 inches of wet snow over 2 inches of mud, and the ground frozen under that. Do you remember? How fast were we going when you slewed me sideways at the bottom to keep from piling up in the creek? Remember? We had the chains on all four and the slope was 35% or was it 45%? It was steep! I couldn't hold it in low range first gear and you kept shifting higher and giving more gas to keep me moving faster than the wheels. We made it though, and the venison was really good, or so you told me. And then the job there ended, and we were off to Oregon. How much weight did you have in that U-Haul anyway? I know it was a lot because we weren't into top gear for the first 100 miles. Over the Divide twice and all across the Palouse. You sure did a lousy job of loading that trailer. Way too much weight on the hitch and my front wheels were barely on the ground. But we made it that time too.

Those were quiet times on Oregon; trips to Saint Helens and the coast range. I really got tired of the rain but I never made you walk. I drank a lot — about a quart every 100 miles. You used me as a geologist would use a Land Rover. It was off to Condon for 2 summers and falls, and then Baker. I loved the dry but the cold got to me. And I didn't like the highway driving when you headed to Portland on the weekend. But I never made you walk, did I? And then you decided that I needed a rebuild and right in the middle you got moved to Wyoming. I thought I was a goner then but you carefully put all my pieces into "baggies" so I would once again be right and able to serve you. Amazing that you only lost one head bolt during that time. When was that? 1977 Or '78? I don't remember. We didn't stay long in Wyoming and next thing we were off to Colorado. And me with a younger sister, or was it a brother. I never figurerd out if a 109" wagon was

sister or brother. Either way, it did a passable job of towing me to Montrose, though I'll never forget that you left the 109" there and drove ME back to Casper. I'm sorry that my heater couldn't keep you warm, especially when your woman was carrying. I tried, but the heater never was enough in the Wyoming winds after you busted up my left door on that cottonwood. But I never made you walk that time either.

There in Colorado your girls came and I found myself sitting so much. Did you outgrow me? Or was I rejected for the 109"? I think that there just wasn't enough room for all of you anymore. Oh sure, you used me when there was a dirty job to do, like hauling a ton and a half of wood out of the Black Canyon of the Gunnison. Remember what you told your woman when she asked how far it was? You said, "13 miles at 14%; that's 2nd gear low range, 2500 rpm, and a six-pack." How many loads did you make me haul, Old Friend? 10,15,20? But I never made you walk, did I?

And then we were all off to Idaho, and that was the only time you insulted me. To be towed behind an International pickup. How could you, after all those years? But when I think about it, I know that it was the way it had to be. You just had too much rolling stock then and I was the easiest one to tow. I didn't even have a flat tire on that trip or throw a recap like the trailer. You sort of forgot about me when you got to Salmon, but that was OK — I needed the rest and was glad for it. Next thing I knew we were off to Phoenix, the 109" was dead, and I was left in charge to guard the place for the next 6 months. I didn't mind, though I would have liked for someone to have swept the snow off me once in awhile. Still, I waited for your return, at last you were back. By then my brakes had gone sour from sitting and you used me as a wheel barrow for a summer. But when you were done fixing, the brakes were better than when I was young.

A few more years went by and you found a 109" pickup and another 88". I was very jealous of the 88" and got the word to your woman that it had to go. Like the true friend that you are, it went, but that junky old pickup stayed and I found myself out to pasture. You only drove me when nothing else ran or when there was really hard work to do. You forgot that my paint was fading just as your hair was graying. We were getting old...

Well, the time finally has come. It's all right Old Friend — I understand. We've never let each other down. I know how hard it is to turn that first screw, but go ahead. I'll never be dead. I know why you are doing this to me,and I don't mind being part of your pickup. I know that you need my transmission and radiator. There will be so many other parts too and I will always be with you in the pickup now. That is surely better than corroding away because you never drive me anymore. One thing I ask, Old Friend — "Please don't haul any of me to the junkyard. We have been together too long for that." Let me keep on, even if it is only a door in California, and a fender in Texas, and maybe a roof in Minnesota, Just promise me that, Old Friend.

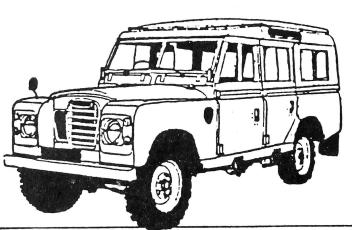

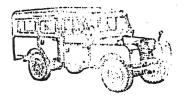
